


## Catalyst's Agile Business Consortium (ABC) Agile Project Management Practitioner Course for IT and non-IT project managers

In October 2016 the DSDM Consortium who developed AgilePM, for Agile Project Management, and AgilePgM, for Agile Programme Management, became the Agile Business Consortium. They are currently creating the new Agile Business Change Framework - building on these tried, tested and trusted products to provide a much wider context for change. (See accompanying flyer).

This three-day training course takes the learning from the AgilePM Foundation course to the next level, digging deeper into the Agile Project Manager's perspective for running a successful Agile project. As with the Foundation course, it will suit anyone who would like to understand how Agile project management can be applied to managing any business project, not just IT projects. It (optionally) leads to Agile Practitioner Level certification through APMG.

### AgilePM

AgilePM is the project manager's perspective on the DSDM Agile Project Framework, the latest version of an approach to project management and delivery that was first released in 1994 and that helped shape the Manifesto for Agile Software Development in 2001. It is owned by the not-for-profit Agile Business Consortium and is free to view and free to use. It presents Principles, Practices, Process, Products and People focussed guidance that helps projects to deliver results quickly and effectively in a wide variety of project types – ranging from small software developments to full-scale business change.

Unlike most other Agile approaches, ABC has a full-project perspective – taking a project from an initial idea all the way through to assessing whether the business objectives for the project have been achieved whilst ensuring appropriate governance and control in a fully Agile way.

### Course Overview

This three day course builds on the Agile Project Management Foundation course to provide

Project Managers and Project Management Officers with the knowledge needed to ensure the success of their Agile projects. Specifically, by the end of this course attendees will understand:

- The practical application of the DSDM principles
- How key project roles contribute to project success
- How to manage their project through its lifecycle
- When and how to use the DSDM products effectively
- The use of MoSCoW and Timeboxing to ensure on-time, on-budget delivery of projects – every time
- How to lead Agile teams to deliver high quality, high value business solutions
- The APMG Practitioner Level exam can be taken at the end of the course

### Who is the course for?

- Anyone currently, or soon to be, engaged actively day-to-day in a project to create or enhance an IT-enabled business solution
- Any project manager who would like to understand how the Agile framework can be applied manage any business project and help accelerate change in the business
